Riding Certification Subcommittee – Amy Causey

- The new scoresheet for the Advanced certification testing is getting good feedback

- The committee is considering revisions to becoming an Advanced faculty member

Driving Certification Subcommittee – Sarah Miller

- The proposal for updates/revamp of the Driving workshop is in process
- The committee's primary focus is considering adding some online components (non-hands on), shortening the time needed for in-person event and hopefully decreasing the costs. The committee is still working on details and is open to experiences from other committees. (Bret shared that it helps to have a story board planned before recording anything.) (Lauren asked if global segments/modules could be created-lesson plans/measurable objectives for example.)
- The committee is also looking at how to get more faculty
- Looking forward to survey results from driving candidates

ESMHL – Nancy Beers

- The ESMHL faculty has been piloting two new pieces to the ESMHL workshop. One is a proximity activity to get the workshop participants up and moving. The other is changes to the Sally role play which had an elaborate script before and now it is more of a discussion instead.

- Making a new EAL video and a new EAP video
- Adding quarterly faculty meetings to help get everyone on the same page and proactively myth busting any misunderstandings

Interactive Vaulting – Liz Adams (Bret)

- Still need an illustrator for more relevant images for updates
- Standardized teaching notes to avoid variations in teaching content
- Need to grow interest in interactive vaulting and how to make certifications more viable. Difficult and not realistic, how to make it more feasible and sustainable
- Difficult to find committee members
- Workshop and teaching notes are priorities.
