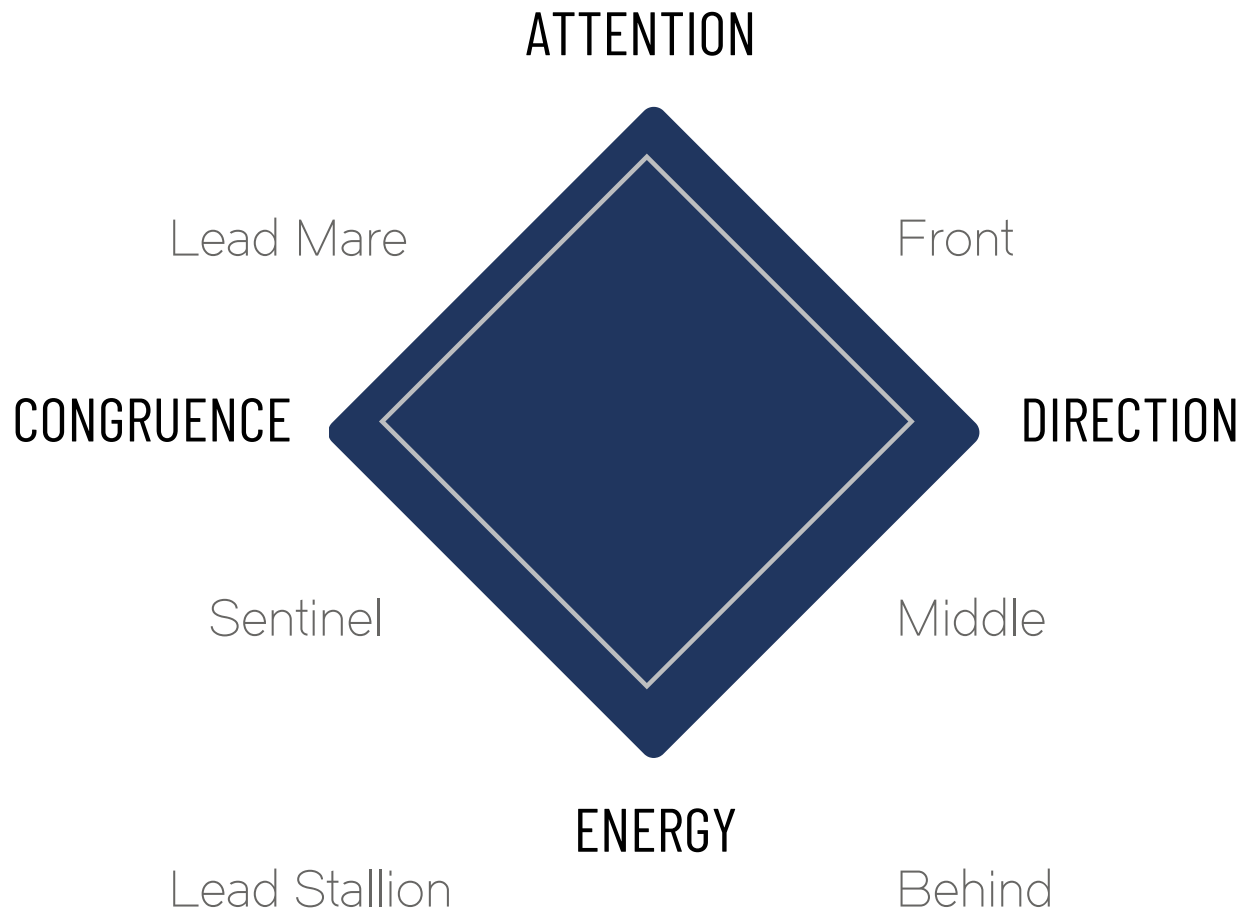


the diamond model of shared leadership
