The Path to Engagement and Participation: Diversity, Equity and Inclusion at the Center Level

Moderated by Michael Kaufmann Farm and Wildlife Director / Green Chimneys, Director of the Sam and Myra Ross Institute, and PATH Intl. Board of Trustees member Join us for an engaging panel dialogue about Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) and discover concrete strategies and action steps centers can take to become more diverse and expand access to EAS for all people. PATH Intl. has set a comprehensive vision, goals and objectives to counter the historical and current lack of diversity within the equine-assisted services industry, particularly with providers, center boards, volunteers and staff. This initiative requires leadership from the regions, local centers and the membership at large.

This panel will delve into the practical elements of exploring and incorporating diversity, equity and inclusion at the local center level. Questions abound. One of the most challenging is how to raise the understanding of DEI within center boards, staff and volunteer teams, when some may not agree or understand the need for these measures. What are the steps to ensuring that policies/procedures/intake paperwork use inclusive language? Should an instructor maintain confidentiality for a young participant who "outs" themselves during lessons but not at home or at school? What obstacles may exist in your community to connect with marginalized and underrepresented individuals, who may be future instructors. great board members, volunteers or participants? These are some areas we will discuss with a panel experienced in DEI. Bring your questions to this free-flowing dialogue and share your DEI successes and challenges. Together we will look at opportunities to build a future that effectively invites everyone to participate in equine-assisted services.
